Starting in 2009, we will post the fall Tradition on our web page so everyone can read and download to their computer or print their own hard copy on their home printer.

We will continue to offer subscriptions of all the issues for each year (fall, winter, spring and any special editions) to anyone who subscribes for the Tradition in a hard copy form. Those subscriptions will be sent by US mail to every subscriber. The price of the subscriptions will remain the same -1 year \$6, 2 years \$11, 3 years \$15.

The Archive Room

The Archive Room has been open during the last month on Tuesdays and Fridays from 2:00PM to 4:00PM. A volunteer is there to answer your questions and help you find the information you are looking for. The room has copies of every yearbook back to the first edition in 1927. We have displays of photographs, letter sweaters, band and sports uniforms, trophies and historic memorabilia on display in the room and in our brand new display showcase just outside the room.

We have a new stained glass window over the doorway of the Archival Room. The window, provided by PSH art teacher Mike Jaszczak (1979 grad), is inspired by a John Remington painting and depicts a lone American Indian on horseback looking across the open plain. Mike donated his time and talent to do the window. I had done research on why we were named the Parma Redmen (loosely derived from the Choctaw word "Oklahoma" meaning red people) and I had written the following for the students to read as they passed by the Archive Room. "In 1926 the alumni and students decided to change the name from the Greyhounds to the Parma Redmen. The students and Alumni wanted an image that exemplified nobility, loyalty and courage.

The American Indian represented these characteristics. Those questions of honesty; their word was their bond; their loyalty was to their family and tribe. They showed their courage despite the overwhelming challenges they faced. They never gave up. Not only did they honor their elders for the wisdom and knowledge that they received from them; but also they respected the earth for what it gave them to survive. The Redmen was named for honor. Mike's stained glass window is a perfect illustration of the story. Come see what we are doing. We are open 2P.M. to 4P.M. Tuesday and Friday.
