Recognition of the Golden Age of PSH Football

The Parma Senior High School Alumni Association honored 4 of the 4 LEL Championship teams from 1958 season (class of 1959) 1959 season (Class of 1960), 1960 season (Class of 1961), and the 1961 season (Classes of 1962 and 1963). The honoring took place at Byers Field at Bob Boulton Stadium in Parma on Friday, August 27 prior to the Parma Senior High School football game against Midpark High. We honored over 50 team members, cheerleaders, coaches and managers from those teams. During a 4 year period these athletes won 4 consecutive Lake Erie League Championships, a feat that no Parma team, before or after has ever done. In so doing, they left their mark on football history not only at PSHS but also on Northeastern Ohio sports. They
