This year we had 3 individuals Neil Hamadey '63, Jon Bailey '56, Mike Jaszczak '80 and the 1960 Reunion Class that donated a total of \$6750.00 for student scholarships at PSH. I will be featuring these individuals and class in this issue of the *Tradition*. **This issue features Jon Bailey from the class of 1956 and Mike Jaszczak class of 1980.**

Jon Bailey from the Class of 1956 has donated \$5000.00 in his parents' name to the Helen and Lee Bailey Parma High Alumni Association Scholarship for the Visual Arts. Jon was a graduate of the Cleveland Art Institute. He worked in the commercial and industrial arts field and he is now a very successful fine artist and illustrator. Jon credits his high school art teacher and the support of his parents for him finding a successful career in the arts. This is the reason that led Jon to establishing a Scholarship in his parents' name at PSH in the visual arts. This past year he gave a \$1000.00 Scholarship to a PSH student going into Computer design at the Columbus College of Arts and Design. Jon is also creating a mentor program for scholarship winners in the field of Art.

Mike Jaszczak from the Class of 1980 donated a scholarship in his mother's name, The Josephine Jaszczak Memorial Scholarship for the Visual Arts. Mike is currently the Art Department chairman at PSH. Mike's mother was supportive of the arts and Mike gave this scholarship to honor her.

Parma's First High School Ohio Historical Marker Dedicated

On June 30th at 3:30 PM, in front of the former location, an Ohio Historical Marker commemorating the site of the first Parma High School was dedicated. The Marker is spectacular as markers go. The real historical significance of that marker is to show how this building changed the course of Parma and the people who lived there. They now had their own High School for their children to graduate from. Until 1921, students who wanted a High School diploma had to spend their senior year at North Royalton or Lincoln High in Cleveland. John Adams makes his own beat

On May 27, 2001, John Adams, Parma Senior High graduate of 1969, celebrated his 3.000 game at the Cleveland Indians game at Progressive Field.... Regarded as the Official Fan of the Cleveland Indians, John is still beating his drum. When asked how he started doing this, he tirelessly repeats the story. Back in August, 1973, at the old Municipal Stadium, he started banging the wooden seats to make some noise to get the fans riled up. He realized that was not enough noisemaking, so he went to garage sales looking for a bass drum. He found one for \$25 and bought it-it is the same one he is using today.

Back in high school, John was always jumping in with two feet to get people involved. A member of the marching band in the percussion section, he started a pep band for the basketball games. Up to that point, there had been no organized band for the team. He also spent evenings and weekends working on stage sets for the Fall and Spring plays that Mr. James Meyer, drama coach, produced.

When the Tribe made the move to Jacob's Field in the early '90's, John and his drum ALMOST did not make the move. The inaugural season was fast approaching and John had not heard whether he and his drum were welcome. ESPN, Atlantic Herald, to name a few medias, were calling him wanting to know where he would be sitting. John called the Indians' front office and told them that he was being contacted by these media people and wanted to know what he should tell them. The front office told him they would get back to him. Two weeks later, he got the call that he could purchase TWO season tickets in the bleachers (the only person to be able to do this). John did and as they say--"the rest is history." John and his drum have also made numerous trips out-of-town as many fields want him to attend... In fact, the year we opened in Minnesota because of the snow-out, John and his drum were flown there by the Indians.

Besides working for AT&T, John teaches aquatic classes at Cleveland State for the adaptive physical education program. He also does numerous other volunteer and charity work for those less fortunate.

A plaque was erected above his seats at Progressive Field commemorating his accom-

plishment. If you do go to a game, you can climb the bleachers and have your picture taken with John and maybe even get him to autograph your program
