Historical Marker Project

Thanks to all that have donated toward the historical plaque that Ed Sarian 58' and the committee of Tony DeMarco 62' Bob Funk 55' and Kenneth Levell, are working on getting erected in front of the original high school on Ridge Road(the former Board Office). To date, you have donated \$180. The PSH Alumni Association will make a donation to help with the sign. The original picture taken in front of the building at the time of dedication in 1921 will be etched into the front of the plaque. The inscription written by Tony DeMarco 62' will read:

Historical Marker Parma High School at the Ridge Road School was dedicated in October of 1921. The building was located on

Ridge Road south of the former Bean Road (Ridgewood Drive). The building was one of 3 buildings designed by Charles W Bates in 1918 for the Parma Rural School District from a bond issue passed by Parma and Parma Heights Township. The board of education was made up of President, H. J. Schaaf, Clerk, L. H. Geiss, board members, C. H. Miller, Carl Uhink, C. C. Crouch and H. C. Hoag.

The senior class consisted of 6 students, 2 boys and 4 girls. Parma Ridge Road High School remained a high school until 1936 when it became a Junior High School. In the 1950's, the school became an elementary school and then in the 1960's it became the Board of Education for the school district until 2006.

In the summer of 1928, an orchard behind the high school was cleared by the football team and became the first Parma High School football field.

Sports Programs in Jeopardy

Due to the third straight new money levy defeat, the Parma Board of Education has instituted the self-funding of our sports programs. That means that no general fund money will be available to be used to support extra-curricular activities. Therefore, each sport program must raise the funds necessary to operate their team. If the total funds are not raised by the participants, the sport will be discontinued. This past spring season, we were unable to field both boys and girls track, and boys tennis due to lack of funding. The following is a list of the cost for each Parma Senior High team:
