

Your column titled "Crisis at PSH" in the latest Alumni Newsletter was quite disturbing. I graduated in 1961 and I remem-

ber the similar issues when I went to school in Parma. I have pictures of my elementary school classes that had 42 students and one teacher. I graduated with over 1000 students.

I don't know if you know of any statistics that would tell me what percent of kids in my class attended college and how many graduated. My guess would be that less than 50% attended and maybe 20% graduated. I wonder if those stats are any different today.

It must be difficult for you to watch this slow decline over the years. You and your wife are doing a great job with the Alumni Organization and all of us appreciate it.

Bob, the classes of the late 50's and 60's were quite large because we were the fastest growing community in the state and the schools could not keep up with the growth. Until the late 60's, most levies were passed. Levy defeats were more common in the 70's and 80's. The system had 9 years of levy defeats from 1969 to 1978.

The records are not very good on the the question of how many attended college from the class of 1961, but it appears that about 55% went on to college/continuing education. My educated guess from the stats of that time is that 30 to 40% graduated from college/continuing education. The Vietnam War may have contributed to the smaller number of graduates because of the draft – (if you

did not complete your college in 4 years, you were eligible for the draft). Today the numbers are up a little from the 60's with more students attending and more graduating from college. More students attend community or Jr. Colleges for the first 2 years because of the costs. Tri C's, a community college in Parma, attendance is up 30% this year alone. Hope this helps to answer your questions

# Letter to yearbook memories Fall 2002 by Barbara Kitchen Siegfried 1955.

I have many found memories of my high school years at the "Queen of High Schools." In fact, I often tell my own high school students about some of the special experiences that occurred during those days.

The activity that stands in my mind was the chartered train trip to Toledo where the Redmen played against Toledo Libby in football. As I can recall the heat did not work on the train, especially on the return trip. With that as an excuse, several couples huddled under the blankets in the dimly lit train. Those of us who

went from car to car selling concession items were a little embarrassed by the coziness of some of the couples - or maybe we were a little jealous. At any rate when I tell of the chartered train for 300 fans to a high school football game, weekly pre-game bonfires to fire up the team even when we lost more games than we won, and the standing room only crowds at Byers field, my basketball-crazy Indiana high school students were amazed.

The football players here were envious of the facilities and the enthusiasm of the fans.

Of course this was the fall of 1954, the last football season before our graduation in the spring of 1955.
