A LITTLE PARMA

HISTORY

My son Jon Bailey a graduate of Parma Senior

High School, lives in Wooster, Ohio. I visit with him and his wife Mary Ann quite frequently. I learned that two of my schoolmates lived about three miles out of Burbank Ohio about eleven miles north of Wooster. The other day I found where they lived and paid them a visit. Ben Brandt was in the class of 1930 and Mildred (Uhinck) Brandt in the class of 1929. Both of them are 91 years old. Mildred graduated with me in 1929. They live on a farm and Ben worked it until a year ago. We shared some memories of bygone days and Mildred being one of the decedents of one of the first families who settled in Parma in 1845 had many stories to tell about her family.

Mildred gave me a copy of the book of the History of Parma Written by Ernest R Kubasek and published in 1976. It is much more complete than the one I have entitled "Historic Keepsake Book Celebrating Parma's Sesquicentennial,1826 to 1976". It contains much more information about Parma's history-much of which Ben, Mildred and I lived.
