# Old Time PSH Cafeteria Recipe

This recipe was from a cookbook given to me by Loretta Timchak when she retired. The first recipe in the c loose



leaf notebook was from 1947. These cookies

were made close to Christmas break. I do not know why they were called Sunset Cookies and not Christmas cookies.

# SUNSET BUTTER COOKIES

2 cups butter

3/4 cup sugar

2 teaspoons vanilla

4 ½ cups all-purpose

1 package green and 1 package red sugar trim

Cream butter, add sugar and blend thoroughly. Add vanilla. Blend in flour gradually. (Start in mixer, but knead in the last of it on a board.) Shape dough into 1½ inch diameter rolls. Roll in colored sugar on waxed paper. Wrap in fresh waxed

paper and refrigerate over night. Cut in ¼ inch slices and bake on ungreased cookie sheet in 375 degree oven 12-15 minutes, just until creamy. Remove immediately. (If difficult to cut dough directly from refrigerator, let stand a few minutes.)
