





TOUR OF THE BUILDING

This issue starts a new feature asked for by a number of alums who have not been back to Parma Sr. High in many years. So here are some photos of places you might remember.

The Little Theater - This photo was take at last May's scholarship announcements. It now has new seating and a new paint job. The stage is in good shape and could provide a good venue for local drama groups.

The Main Hallway entry. This used to be the main entry to the building, but since the addition on the front of the building it now serves as the entry to the Board of Education. This area is now the PSH Alumni Hall of Fame. Inductees photos are displayed with their bios. The terrazzo floors and steel lettering on the floor (Parma Senior High) are beautiful.

The Gym Entry and Showcase area—This area has two large showcases with all the league and individual State and League. Other trophy showcases and displays are in this hallway along with the main gym, the auxiliary gym, and the pool.

This the Main Office - This is the location of the secretaries and mailboxes for the teachers. It is also the location where visitors come and where students are summoned from classrooms to meet with the Principal and assistant Principal This hallway also has the clinic, psychologist, and other offices.

This is the Band Room The band room has not changed in 40 years. The instruments and chairs have been upgraded and the lighting is better. The band and the orchestra practice here and perform at Byers Field and school concerts. With declining enrollment. the band is smaller. The bands in the 50's/60's had well over 100 members.
