Mahogany Cottingham Breaks School Records for points in a season

Congratulations to Freshman Guard, Mahogany Cottingham who has broken the school record for points in a season. With her 22 point performance on Saturday afternoon she has tallied 369 points on the year, surpassing the old record of 361 points. The record was previously held by Lindsay Humbel who tallied 361 points in 2016-17 season. Mahogany has proven herself as an elite scorer as a freshman, breaking the record in just 15 games

The record is added to the three other school records she has already broken this year: Points in a single game 42 old record 41 Steals in a single game -13 old record 12 Steals in a season: - 103 old record 102 Remember there were at least 5 games left before the tournaments when the season ended. Mahogany, a freshman was recently selected, a as one of the top 48 players in North East Ohio by the coaches and the PD Dealer.

A historical factoids THE PARMA SCHOOLS DURING THE DEPRESSION

In the 30's teaching was different than today. First of all 80-90per cent of teachers were female. They could not be married and if they got married they had to quite. The second fact unique to Parma, was that Parma began using script that they printed to pay teachers, they in turn paid for rent and food with that script. The store owners and landlords would exchange that script with the school district for US currency. Unfortunately this was illegal. The federal government charged the district with counterfeiting and forced them to stop. Unfortunately the school system would not give the store owners, landlords and teachers back real money for the script they had. It left a bad taste for years between school system and the business owners and teachers.
